RMUTP accepts applications from disabled students at the undergraduate level in 7 faculties.

RMUTP is open for the admission of disabled students, aiming to promote and support educational opportunities for disabled individuals who have the ability to learn, ensuring equal access to education as the general population. The objective is to promote the dissemination of educational opportunities and create educational equality for disabled individuals to access education at the tertiary level. For the academic year 2565, admissions are open for 7 faculties, including the Faculty of Industrial Education, Faculty of Industrial Technology, Faculty of Business Administration, Faculty of Science and Technology, Faculty of Arts, Faculty of Textile Industry and Fashion Design, and the Faculty of Architecture and Design.

RMUTP collaborates to create opportunities for people with disabilities.

On November 22, 2022, RMUTP, in collaboration with the Development of the Potential of Persons with Disabilities Foundation, held a scholarship award ceremony for physically and mobility-impaired students who excel academically and demonstrate good behavior but lack financial resources in educational institutions within the Bangkok metropolitan area, surrounding provinces, as well as three southern border provinces. Air Vice Marshal Poradat Koomtara, President of the Development of the Potential of Persons with Disabilities Foundation, served as the chairman of the ceremony, and Assistant Professor Dr. Nat Charaythorn Watsathit korasiri, Deputy Dean of the Faculty of Industrial and Collaborative Education, represented Rajamangala University of Technology Phra Nakhon in the discussion on the topic "Seizing New Opportunities Through Our Hands." Additionally, representatives from the Faculty of Engineering, the Digital and Robotic Innovation Institute, exhibited their academic achievements to the participating students at the Impact Forum Center in Nonthaburi.

RMUTP has signed a memorandum of understanding with the Disabled People Development Foundation to create educational opportunities for people with disabilities and reduce social inequalities.

On January 21, 2022, Dr. Nattawat Ratchasiriwattanabul, the President of Rajamangala University of Technology Phra Nakhon, signed a memorandum of understanding with Air Chief Marshal Sathitpong Angkasith, the Chairman of the Disabled People Development Foundation, regarding the creation of educational opportunities for people with disabilities to promote equal development.
