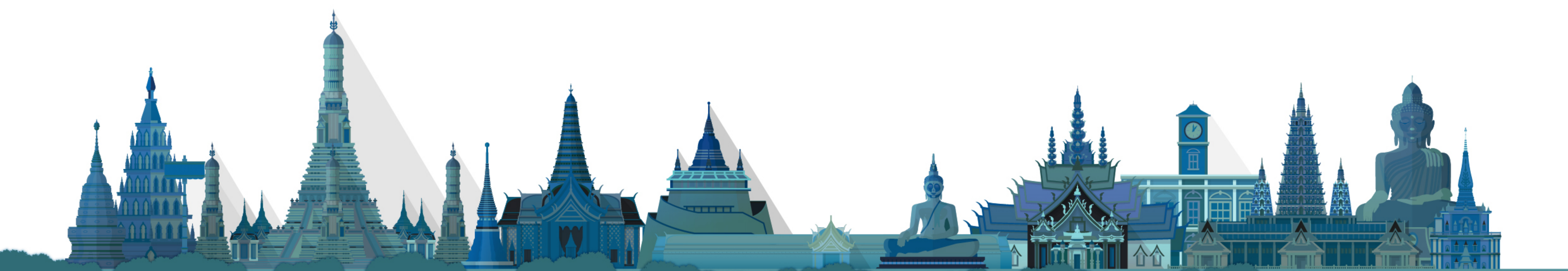


RMUTP announces its commitment to promoting integrity, fostering morality, and transparency in its administration.

## RMUTP organizes training on administrative law.

President of Rajamangala University of Technology Phra Nakhon (RMUTP), served as the presiding officer for the opening ceremony of the Knowledge Management (KM) Project Phase 3, which focused on fundamental knowledge of administrative law. This event was organized by the Legal Affairs Office in commemoration of the day similar to the anniversary of the passing of His Royal Highness Prince Rapipat, which falls on August 7th each year. Prince Rapipat, was recognized as the "Father of Thai Law" due to her significant contributions to Thai jurisprudence.

The event aimed to promote an understanding of administrative law and to align with the ethical principles of RMUTP. The knowledge was shared by legal experts, with Mr. Phorchai Manasriphan, the Chairman of the Environmental Cases Department at the Supreme Administrative Court, serving as a guest speaker. The training session was attended by university executives, staff, and students, with approximately 100 participants, both in-person and online, taking part in the event. The event was held at the Rapipat Meeting Room at RMUTP's Office of the President.
