



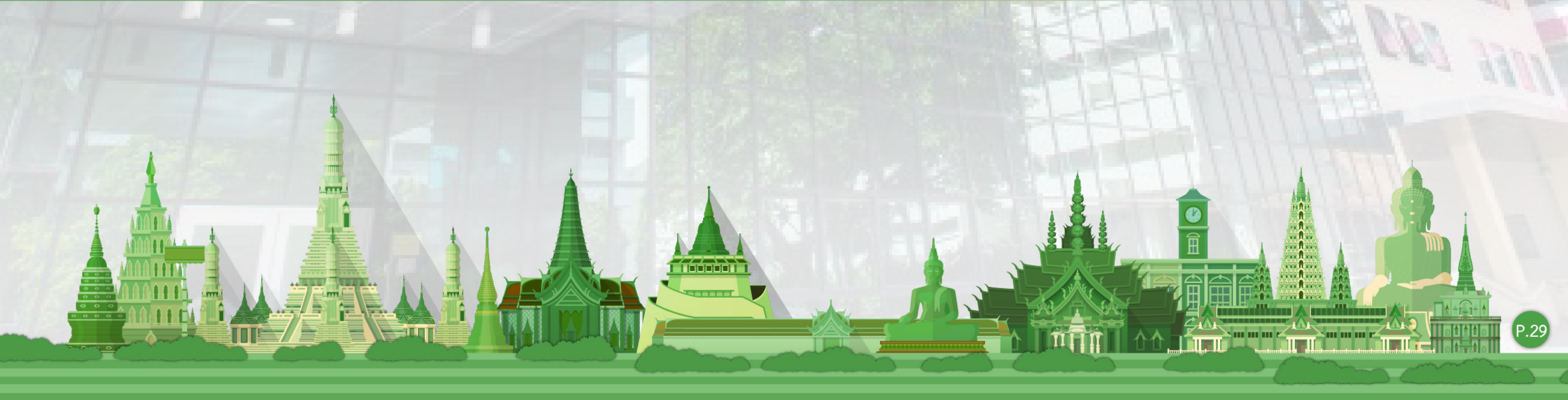

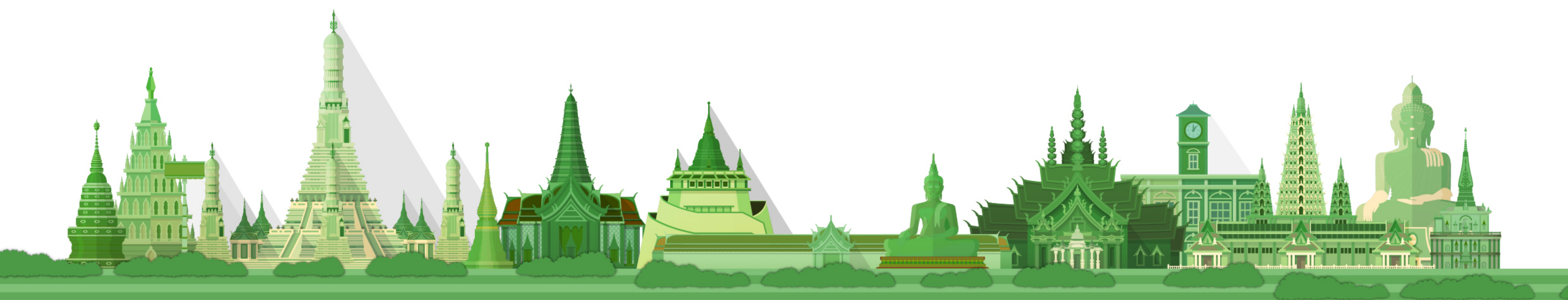

Smoke-free policy in place

President of Rajamangala University of Technology Phra Nakhon, appointed Associate Professor Sarathat Kaengpheankhae and Miss Malika Veerasai as representatives of the university to receive the "Smoke-Free Educational Institution" award for the year 2022 from the Thai Health Professional Network for Tobacco Control. They also received a certificate of honor for being a role model institution in promoting tobacco control efforts from 2021 to 2023 from the National Network for a Smoke-Free Thailand.

During the event, Professor Emeritus Dr. Somsee Phaosawasdi, President of the Medical Council of Thailand, presented the awards. The Thai Health Professional Network for Tobacco Control recognized Rajamangala University of Technology Phra Nakhon as an educational institution that strongly supports and promotes tobacco control efforts. Additionally, the university's significant contributions to tobacco control advocacy were acknowledged during the event.

This recognition was given at the "Clear Sky Academic Conference" and the annual general meeting of the National Network for a Smoke-Free Thailand in 2022. It was held at the Chalmrphrakiat Building in the 50th Anniversary of Siam Makro, Chalmr Phrakiat Building, and sponsored by the Medical Association of Thailand under the Royal Patronage.
